



Nearly 200 Christians Are Killed For Their Faith

Every month nearly 200 Christians worldwide are killed for their faith. One study revealed that Christians are the most persecuted group in the world, and it is getting worse every year. India has turned into one of the most hostile and dangerous places for Christian individuals and churches. Hindu radicals view Christians as outsiders representing a western religion, and for that Christians are experiencing increasing persecution. These radicals are intent on cleansing India of Christianity and Islam through violence. The central and state governments provide no protection for law-abiding, nonviolent Christians who are practicing their faith. Instead, the government continues to look the other way when religious minorities are attacked. Even in the cities Christians face discrimination and intimidation such as being overlooked for jobs or refused permits, among other things. Pray for Christian converts who are forcefully pressured to return to Hinduism. In recent years, Hindu organizations have become more aggressive, claiming that India belongs to Hinduism. They torch churches, targeting poor congregations who meet in huts that burn down quickly.

In the last ten years, one main focus of Mission in Action has been to build churches in villages where believers will have a place to worship the Lord in spirit and in truth without fear of arson. Our goal is to build 700 church buildings like the one pictured below, a solid construction made of bricks and cement that can better withstand fire and other means of destruction. With the donation of \$3800 we can provide believers in a village with a safe place of worship. We have already built 57 of these simple, safe and cost efficient church facilities, and we are believing for the rest to come so we can help our fellow Christians live their faith.

My Mother Have Abandoned Me, But Jesus Never Will



The girl on the left is Sarida, 12 years of age, and she said: "When I was 5 years old, I woke up one morning and saw lot of feet going around and over me. I found myself in a Railway station, and my mother was nowhere to be found. I cried for her for hours. Some said, your mother has abandoned you, and went on. I was very sad and could not understand, but I have never seen or heard from my mother since that day. Later that evening I was so hungry I could not bare the pain. Someone brought me to the children home, and that night I ate my first meal there. They washed me, gave me new clothes and a blanket and pillow to sleep. When they put me in bed, they prayed over me and said, this is your home. This has been my home ever since I came here and I have many sisters in the children home and Uncle and Aunt and everyone has been taking good care of me. My mother may have abandoned me, but Jesus will never leave me or forsake me."



Intense poverty, hunger, drought, natural disasters and malaria have contributed to the estimated 30 million orphans in India. In recent years, AIDS has played an increasingly bigger role in this sad statistic, and India is now ranking as the country with the most HIV infections in the world. 
A Bible For All

India has the largest number of leprosy patients in the world. They are outcast from society and forgotten because of their condition. It is a chronic infectious disease that literally eats the person alive. There is a cure for all types of leprosy, yet in India the disease is a growing problem. Even doctors struggle to diagnose leprosy. By the time many of these people have been diagnosed they have already lost fingers, toes, even their eyesight, and are made to live in very dirty, run-down leprosy colonies. Since they are unable to take care of themselves, conditions in the colonies are very poor and desperate, it's sad to see.

Our ministry is reaching out to these people to help them with food and medicine, and ministering to them the Word of God. This woman, whose fingers are all eaten by leprosy, wanted a Bible to read in her own language. We gave Bibles to everyone who could read in the leprosy colony and they are so thankful.
